With the COVID-19 situation remaining highly volatile around the country, MANIAX has made the heart-breaking decision to postpone the 2021 Asia Pacific Axe Throwing Championship Finals until February 2022.

We'd hate to imagine a scenario where all of our competitors have flown in from interstate only for the host venue's city to go into lockdown - and that's a real possibility for the remainder of 2021.

We're hopeful that Second Chance Qualifiers will still be able to take place in each venue prior to Christmas, and we're looking forward to seeing you guys bring your A-Game to these battles. Second Chance Qualifiers will fall on different dates in each venue, COVID pending, with the current plan being for them to take place in early November, on a weeknight. Additional announcements will be made regarding these dates closer to the time.
